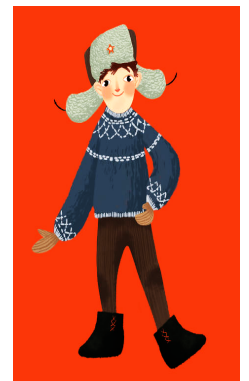
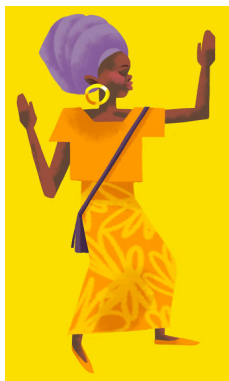


# CLOTHES FROM AROUND THE WORLD
